ART OF DINING 2013

Honoring Legendary Filmmaker and Artist David Lynch
Friday, May 17, 6 pm
Balboa Bay Resort

Newport Beach, CA—The Orange County Museum of Art's **Art of Dining**, the museum's major annual gala and the premier event celebrating creativity and artistic excellence in our community, will take place at **6 pm on Friday, May 17th at the Balboa Bay Resort**. The event raises funds to support the museum's critically acclaimed exhibition program as well as its free school programs, which serve more than 6,000 students each year, many from extremely disadvantaged districts that could not afford to visit otherwise.

Each year, Art of Dining honors an individual of international acclaim who has made an important impact in the art world. This year's honoree is the legendary filmmaker, musician, and visual artist David Lynch. His work includes the renowned films *Blue Velvet* and *Mulholland Drive*, and the epic television series *Twin Peaks*. He is an accomplished musician and has produced, written lyrics, and composed songs for many of his films and is an exceptional visual artist. Prior to his work in film, he was trained as a painter and has exhibited his artwork worldwide, including a major art retrospective at the Fondation Cartier, Paris (2007) that showcased paintings, photographs, drawings, alternative films, sound work, and site-specific art installations. In addition, Lynch is the founder and chairman of the David Lynch Foundation for Consciousness-Based Education and World Peace.

"To honor David Lynch is especially important as he represents the highest standards of artistic integrity across virtually every media," said OCMA Director Dennis Szakacs. "David is unique in that he has a powerful vision that is expressed in whatever he touches, one that rings true and clear, and is unafraid to address the maddening and strange undercurrents of ordinary existence."

At the event on May 17th, guests will first enjoy a cocktail reception in the Coconut Grove at Balboa Bay Resort, followed by dinner and dancing in the Grand Ballroom. This year's event features a menu created by the Resort's renowned Executive Chef Josef Lageder. Art of Dining attracts over 300 attendees annually and raises funds for OCMA's extraordinary exhibition and education programs. Table reservation information is available at www.ocma.net.
